About the speaker

Neta C. Crawford is the Montague Burton Professor of International Relations at University of Oxford. Prior to that she was professor and chair of the Department of Political Science at Boston University. In addition to *The Pentagon, Climate Change, and War* (MIT Press, 2022) Crawford is the author of *Accountability for Killing: Moral Responsibility for Collateral Damage in America's Post-9/11 Wars* (Oxford University Press, 2013); *Argument and Change in World Politics: Ethics, Decolonization and Humanitarian Intervention* (Cambridge University Press, 2002) winner of a 2003 award from the American Political Science Association; and the co-editor of *How Sanctions Work: Lessons from South Africa* (1999). Her first book, *Soviet Military Aircraft* (Lexington Books), was published in 1987. She has served on the editorial board of the *American Political Science Review*. Crawford is a founder and co-director of the Costs of War Project, found at costsofwar.org.
