The Global Water Security Center (GWSC) is a DoD-funded center at the University of Alabama that develops, maintains, and interprets water and environmental security data and information. GWSC has identified barriers to the uptake and use of water and environmental information in security decisions. Dr. Brauman will discuss GWSC's approach to translating water information for DoD users and present a working framework to help decision makers understand the linkages from water events to potential insecurity.

Her research includes assessment of global trends in water consumption and availability, irrigation/agricultural water use, and investments in watershed ecosystem services.
