Wargame Objective:

Assess the performance and survivability of Class III delivery connectors (current and future platforms) to meet end-user fuel delivery demands in a contested battlespace.

Wargame Scenario:

The wargame is conducted in two rounds. Round one is played with a pre-established mix of connectors. In round two, the user customizes the mix of connectors. Blue team plans and executes strategies to deliver Class III material to sustain operations at four key demand nodes. Red team acts as the enemy force and attempts to interdict delivery by destroying Blue connectors.
