1. The Department of Defense (DOD) Program for Stability of Civilian Employment, commonly referred to as the Priority Placement Program (PPP), has traditionally provided effective outplacement assistance for DOD civilian employees affected by reduction-in-force (RIF), base closures, consolidations, position classification decisions, rotation from overseas, and transfers of function (TOF). This program is the premier outplacement program in the Federal Government for reducing the adverse effects of downsizing on our civilian workforce. During the present era of transition within the Department of Defense, the PPP stands to play an even larger role in minimizing the disruptions that come along with major organizational changes.
