## TIO OVERVIEW

Since 1996, the Naval Postgraduate School (NPS) and the Center for Joint Services Electronic Warfare have sponsored an international, 3-week, technical short course – Technologies for Information Operations (TIO). TIO is a non-degree short course taught in residence at NPS.

## BENEFIT

TIO is practical education for tomorrow's technology warfighters. TIO provides students an opportunity for technical interchange in areas of emergent technologies in topic areas like Electromagnetic Maneuver Warfare, Military Operations, Threat Assessments, Unmanned Systems, Intercept Sensors, OR Decision-making Tools, Technology Information, and National Security. Most importantly, TIO is a valuable forum for coalition building.

## INSTRUCTION AND LOCATION

TIO is taught by world class NPS faculty members who are subject matter experts in their fields of study. TIO includes on-campus laboratory tours, exercises, and demonstrations. Due to the unique location of NPS, TIO also features off-campus site visits to various defense related engineering facilities and innovation leaders in the region.

## ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

- MASL # P179220
- TIO is open to mid to high-level officers (03-06)
- Pre-requisites: Technical background in either an engineering discipline, systems analysis, information sciences or operations research.
- Language proficiency: TIO is taught in English. Students must demonstrate proficiency in English via a minimum English Comprehension Level (ECL) score of 80.
- All interested participants must submit an application through the applicant's Ministry of Defense to the Training Office in the US Embassy in the applicant's country.
- Tuition and invitational travel orders are handled through the Joint Security Cooperation Education and Training Program.
- Rooms are available on campus at NPS. Room reservations will be coordinated in conjunction with the enrollment process.
