

V. CAMPGROUND EVALUATION GUIDE

A. Requirements:

1. Electrical

- a. Are unused openings in boxes, conduit bodies, raceways, cabinets, auxiliary gutters, equipment cases, cutout boxes, housings and fittings properly closed? (Yes No)
- b. Does each outlet box have a cover, faceplate, fixture canopy and are they undamaged? (Yes No)
- c. Are circuit breakers legibly marked to indicate their purpose? (Yes No)
- d. Are live electrical parts guarded against accidental contact? (Yes No)
- e. Do all 125-volt 15 and 20 amp receptacles installed in bathrooms have GFCI protection? (Yes No)

B. Recommendations:

1. Site Selection:

- a. Are sites free of rock outcrops and heavy undergrowth? (Yes No)
- b. Are weeds cut regularly to reduce insect, snake and small animal hazards? (Yes No)
- c. Are sites well drained and gently sloped? (Yes No)
