Think of the abstract as a classified ad for your work, one in which you are being charged by the word. An NPS thesis abstract can be no more than 1,500 characters, including spaces (around 200 words).

Include these elements



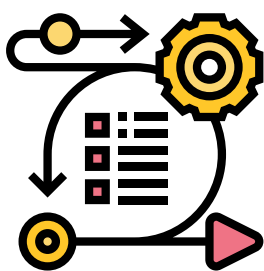
Background & Research Problem

What problem or gap in understanding exists that your research helps address?



Purpose

What does your research aim to do?



Methods

How did you collect and analyze evidence to answer your research question?



Results

What did you discover?
How do your findings help solve the problem?



Recommendations

How can your readers or stakeholders use your research? What comes next?



If using citation-worthy outside information, mention the source in your sentence. Do not use citations.
