

Capitalize proper nouns

**Capitalize official names** 

Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) European Union (EU) Department of Justice (DOJ)

Lowercase generic words

energy management system (EMS) hybrid energy storage system (HESS) software-defined network (SDN) unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) improvised explosive device (IED)

Lowercase when not part of a name

Capitalize when part of a name

**President** George Washington **Chief of Naval Operations Admiral** M. Gilday


Capitalize when referring to a region

Iran wants to reduce pressure from the **West**.

The focus has shifted from the **Middle East** to the great power competition.

Lowercase when referring to a point on the compass

They entered from the **north**. The current flows **west**.

Lowercase unless formed from a person's name

general relativity Bernoulli's principle Euler method utilitarianism Trotskyism communism realism



#### **ARMED FORCES**

Capitalize official branch names

the U.S. Navy the Chilean Army the People's Liberation Army Navy

Capitalize only for U.S. forces

the Navy the Army the Marines the Air Force the Coast Guard
