ADD'S TO THE END

The policy's objectives

APA (7TH ED.) DOES THIS REGARDLESS OF HOW THE WORD ENDS. CHICAGO, ON THE OTHER HAND, HAS SOME EXCEPTIONS:

WHEN A SINGULAR POSSESSIVE ENDS IN "S," ADD 'S AFTER THE S.

The bus's passengers

EXCEPT

WHEN THE SINGULAR AND PLURAL FORMS OF A NOUN ENDING IN "S" ARE THE SAME

- politics'
- series'

WHEN THE LAST ELEMENT OF AN OFFICIAL NAME IS A PLURAL FORM ENDING IN "S" (BUT THE NOUN ITSELF IS SINGULAR)

- United States'
- Special Forces'

FOR THESE EXCEPTIONS JUST ADD AN APOSTROPHE

IF THE ENDING "S" INDICATES A PLURAL, ADD JUST THE APOSTROPHE AFTER THE S.

- The policies' objectives
- The buses' passengers

NOT FOR PLURALS



- The Joneses







NOT WMD's



NOT Jones's or Jones'
