- 1. What are the dimensions that must be considered in delineating what decision-making authority should/must remain with humans vs. what can be delegated to Intelligent Autonomous Systems?

Study approach—question #1

- What are the dimensions that must be considered in delineating what decision-making authority should/must remain with humans vs. what can be delegated to Intelligent Autonomous Systems?
 - Identify the concerns/risks that must be addressed before granting decision making authority
 - In the form of questions/checklists
 - Review a large and diverse collection of documents:
 - Al & robotics roadmaps, plans, strategies, SOPs, etc.
 - DOD, USG, allied and adversary foreign governments, NATO, UN, commercial unmanned vehicles, etc.
 - Doctrine and targeting manuals
 - Groups opposed to lethal autonomous weapons
 - Commissions, think tanks, FFRDCs, UARCs
 - Affinitize these "elements" into dimensions

Study approach—question #2

- How can DOD incorporate these dimensions into a framework that will guide the development, fielding, integration, and employment of militarily effective, legally compliant, and ethically conforming Intelligent Autonomous Systems?
 - Still to be determined, but:
 - We want to "test drive" our proposed checklists/ dimensions with groups of SMEs
 - With participants of a/the 3000.9 mock review?
 - With developmental testing SMEs?
 - With operational testing SMEs?
 - With an operational commander's staff?
