



AI for Knuckledraggers is a 1-day (7 hour) overview of Artificial Intelligence for non-technical people who do not have a deep understanding of AI. It addresses current concerns and issues about AI, separating myth from fact and provides a framework for how to think about AI as a technology including how it can be harnessed by people and organizations. The course does not teach coding or AI engineering skills but instead touches on a wide range of topics:

- How to think about machine intelligence
- Its history and growth over the years
- The analytical foundations that can produce intelligence
- Different types of AI and how they work, including Generative AI
- AI use cases
- Deploying AI at scale across and enterprise
- Ethical considerations and Responsible AI
- AI in the DOD
